Smithfield (Fort Boykin Historic Park) 5/10 Km Walk

LOCATION: Fort Boykin Historic Park, 7410 Fort Boykin Trail, Smithfield, VA

DISTANCE: There will be a choice of a 5- or 10-kilometer walk available.

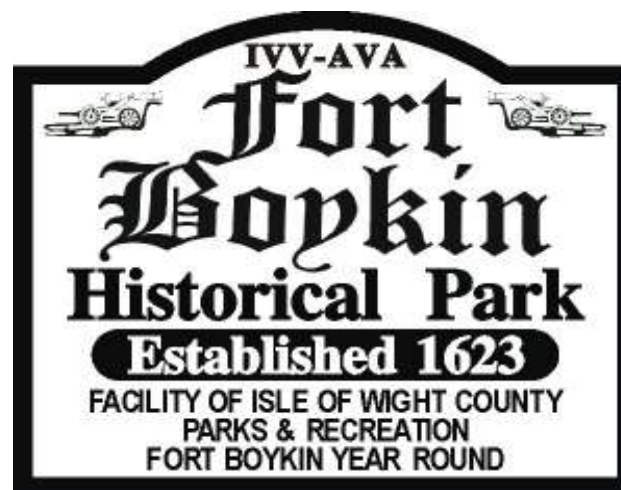
START AND FINISH TIMES: Daily from 8 a.m. until dark.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES: The box is at Smithfield Station. **Since two walks start from here (The Gator Volksmarsch Club has a walk that goes through Historic Smithfield), insure that you have the walk box for this event.** Driving instructions from Smithfield Station to Fort Boykin Historic Park are provided with the trail directions. Complete the paperwork for the event by following the instructions in the box. Remember that the start point is a business. Please be patient while they wait on their customers.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Walk trail rating 2B. The trail is along the shoulder of country roads and along the James River. It is suitable for strollers and handicapped.

DIRECTIONS

SMITHFIELD – FORT BOYKIN: You will be driving first to Smithfield Station, 415 South Church St, Smithfield to register. From Richmond and the Hampton/Newport News area, take I-64 East to Exit 263 (Mercury Boulevard/Route 258 South). Turn right on Mercury Boulevard. Cross the James River Bridge, staying on Route 258 South to Business 10/258 into Smithfield. Continue on Business 10 (Church Street) to Smithfield Station. The restaurant and hotel will be on your right just after crossing the Cypress Creek Bridge. After registering at Smithfield Station you will drive to Fort Boykin.
